Instruction for using shloshim.org

- 1. Register.
 - a. The registration process is quick and easy and free.
 - i. Enter you name, email address and password. Click register and you are done.
 - ii. You only need to register once.
- 2. Sign On
 - a. Enter your email address that you used to register and the password you chose to sign on.
- 3. Create Shloshim list.

Go to http://www.shloshim.org and register if you do not have an account, or sign in if you have used the site before.

- a. Click the button that says create a new Shloshim list.
 - i. A section should appear that will allow you to enter the name of the *Niftar*. This name is the Hebrew name of the deceased. This is the name that people should have in mind when studying their *Mishnayos*.
 - ii. English name of the *Niftar*. This is the name that the deceased was known as. Enter the deceased first and last name. This name will be searchable from the search box.
 - iii. Family Members. The names entered in this box will become searchable in the search box. The reason we ask for this information is only to allow people to easily find your list by being able to enter a name of the relative to find the correct list.
 - iv. Date of the Shloshim is the date the Mishnayos need to be completed.
 - v. Click the button that says Create List
- 4. Search for a list

- a. After you sign in or register, you can use the search box to look for a *Shloshim* list.
 - i. Enter the name of the deceased or any of the family members (first name or last name or anything you remember). If there is a match the list will display.
- 5. Volunteer to learn Mishnayos.
 - a. After you search for a list, you can select an individual list by clicking on it.
 - b. The available *Mishnayos* for that list will be displayed.
 - c. Check the box next to the *Mishnayos* you want to pledge.
 - d. Scroll down to the bottom of the screen and click the pledge button.
 - You will receive a reminder email with a confirmation of you pledge.

6. Send Reminder

- a. The send reminder button is available on the admin view of the *Shloshim* list you created.
 - i. Clicking this button will send a reminder email to everyone that pledged to learn *Mishnayos* for your list on shloshim.org.

7. Edit you list

- a. You can change the name or *Shloshim* date of the *Shloshim* list you created by clicking the Edit link
- 8. View your list
 - a. You can view the *Shloshim* list you created and see who pledged what by clicking the link in the "*Shloshim* lists I created" section.

9. Mark Completed

a. When you complete your pledge, you should log in and click the completed checkbox and click update to let the owner of the list know that you completed your pledge.
